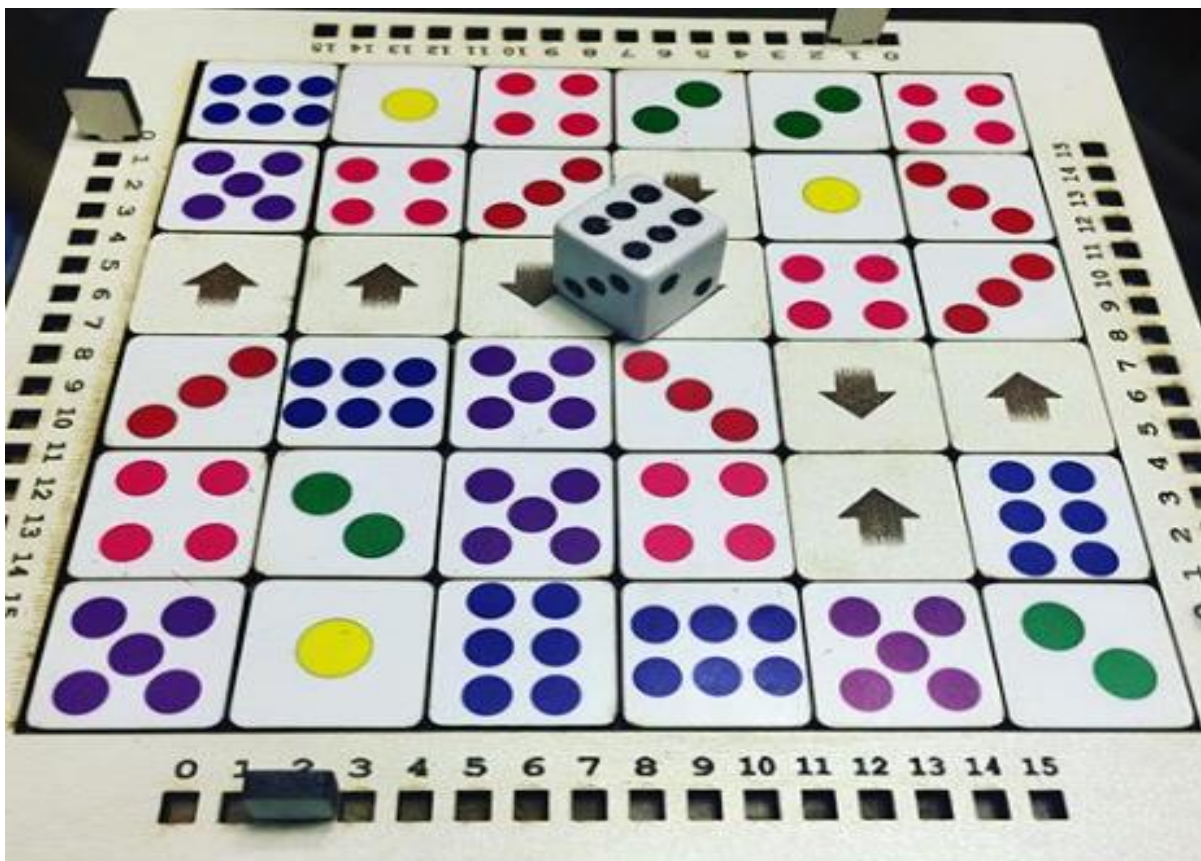


# DIE TAC TOE

## Abstract Dice Game

(Updated February 26, 2020)

**Die Tac Toe** is an abstract strategy game where two to four players attempt to control sufficient territory to score points. Players take turns flipping tiles in a 6x6 grid using single die rolls. The arrows on the flip side will point towards the player. Aligning enough adjacent arrows towards a player causes the player to score one point.



## **LASERCUT COMPONENTS:**

- 6x6 game board for up to four players with ...
- 4 integrated scoring tracks and score markers
- 36 numbered tiles (1-6)
- Two dice.

**SETUP:** Place all the tiles face up in the grid randomly. Reset the score board markers to 0. Refer to the “Winning Patterns” below for scoring differently by number of players.

## **GAME PLAY:**

On each turn, a player will...

- Roll one die
- Flip any tile that matches the die roll
- Look for sufficient adjacent arrow alignments to score one point (see note below)
- After scoring, flip the tiles back to their numbered faces

## NOTES:

- With **two** players, align five adjacent arrows to score
- With **three** or **four** players, align four adjacent arrows
- When a die roll has **no matching tile**, choose a random opponent's arrow and flip it over to reveal its number. Should the number match the die roll, flip it over and point the arrow to you. Score if possible.

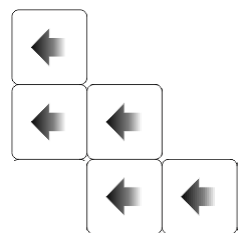
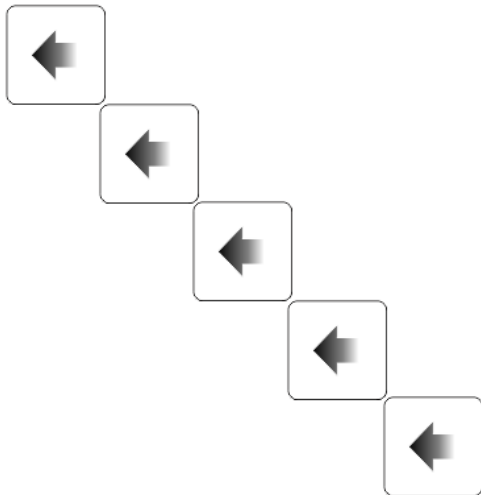
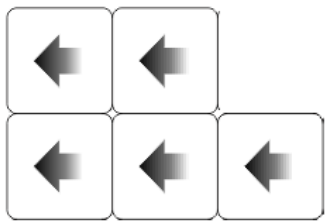
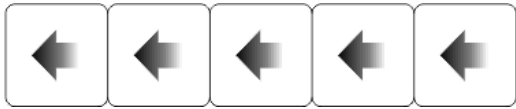
## STRATEGIES:

- Don't always flip a tile to point to yourself. Thwart your opponent with a potential block.
- Try to remember where numbers are in case you get a chance to flip back an arrow (when there is no match).

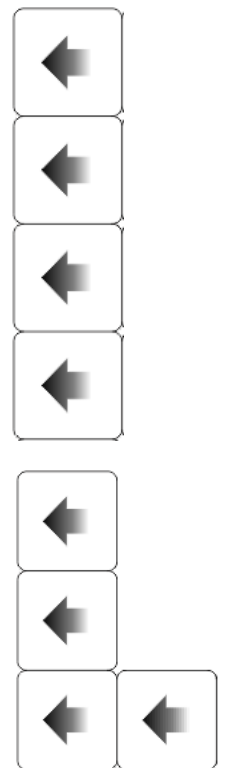
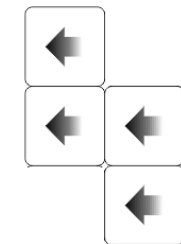
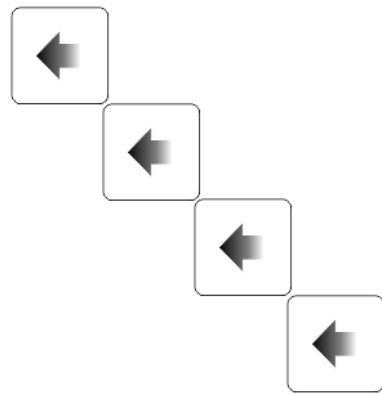
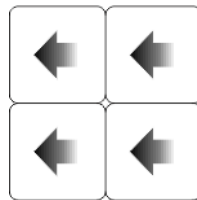
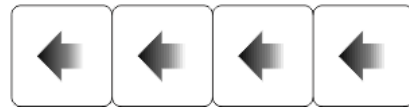
## WINNING PATTERNS:

To score one point, align your arrows in an adjacent pattern. Some examples:

**Four Players:** Three in a line horizontally, vertically or diagonally.
